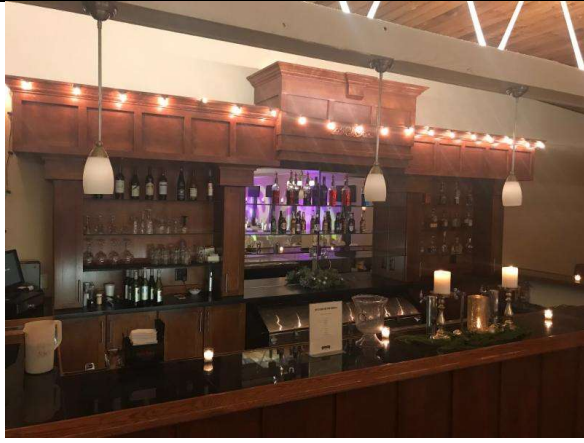
make you think about someone that might be a good candidate to join Lakeside Country Club.
